THE ARTS HUB MAKERS GALLERY

This is a large marquee located in the car park of the Recreation Reserve. Food & alcohol are supplied by the Newstead Football Netball Club.

Community Centre

The main hall is one of the prime venues of the festival. The Café operates in the old section, featuring Thai food, and a beer and wine bar. The hall and the café are both airconditioned.

Lilliput

This is the local kindergarten and pre-school. It provides a more intimate space for performers, and is airconditioned.

The Anglican Church

Located across the street from The Troubadour, immerse yourself in the delightful acoustic sound in this tiny country church.

The Enviroshop

The refurbished workshop of an old service station, this operates commercially as a business with a focus on sustainable energy solutions. Located 400m from the Community Centre.

Playground Park

Officially named Newstead Park but known locally as The Playground Park or The Pirate Park. This is where Tai Chi happens.

Live'n'Local Stage

An outdoor stage which celebrates all types of music featuring local artists. The stage operates on Saturday and Sunday and is located in the Festival Village in Panmure Street. This is a FREE VENUE.

The Courtyard

Located on the main street near Festival Reception, this is a lovely courtyard setting under a cool peppercorn tree. This is a FREE VENUE.

Butterland

This is the old Butter Factory. Longer running, themed shows are held here. Finger food and alcohol available.

The Red Shed

The old railway goods shed is now a printmakers workshop. During the festival, the printing presses will be moved aside to make way for workshops and the festival choir.

The Arts Hub

The old stationmaster's house, this is the venue for the Makers Gallery, showcasing a variety of handmade instruments. Coffee cart & afternoon bar. Open Sat & Sun 10am-5pm, Mon 9am-12noon.
